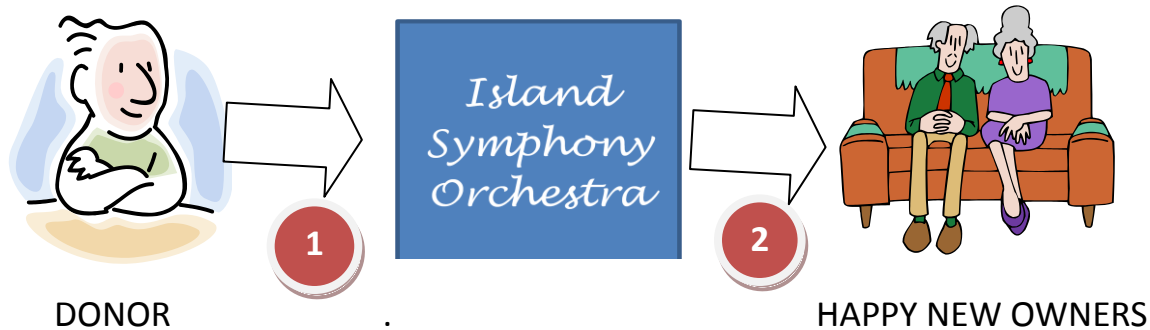


# GIFTS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

## HOW IT WORKS:

Donor donates a valuable painting, antiques, musical instrument, or other marketable property to the Island Symphony Orchestra.

The ISO may hold, sell, or otherwise dispose of the property at some point in the future and use the proceeds for its mission.

## BENEFITS TO YOU:

- You receive gift credit and an immediate tax deduction for the appraised value of your gift, and pay no capital gains tax (which could be due if you sold the property), as long as the gift can be used by the ISO to carry out its mission. (Please contact the ISO to determine if your gift has value to the ISO.)
- You retain the flexibility of a gift commitment that doesn't affect your current cash flow.
