

ISO Membership Guide

Welcome to the Island Symphony Orchestra. We are happy for your membership which we value and respect. Every rehearsal should be a worthwhile experience with a team you enjoy being part of. Here are some guidelines and expectations for all members.

1. Members are advised that anything over two absences will need clearance from the conductor in order to play that cycle's concert.
 - a. Dress Rehearsal is mandatory. If a situation should arise, please discuss with the conductor.
2. Dues for the Season are \$100.00 payable by mid-October. Treasurer Lynne Bowden will be collecting the dues and will answer any questions.
3. Principal players are responsible for their sections and should be the first contact point for members. Principal players will also keep available an extra folder for subs or new members so that music for rehearsal is always available. The Music Director will have the final say regarding personnel changes.
4. Music must be marked with all requested markings and measure numbers as requested by the conductor. Bowings for stringed instruments will be provided by the Principal Player.
5. Information about potential new members should be shared with the Director of Personnel and the Conductor.
6. All ISO owned concert music will be returned at the end of each concert. Rental music must be returned in the same condition you received it in.
7. There will be a \$15.00 charge for missing folders.
8. All Board members are available to address your questions and concerns.
